Council may or may not issue a permit with or without conditions and may also cancel a permit at any time. A permit will be valid for 12 months upon being issued and is not transferable.

If you are applying for a new permit please submit the application 14 days prior to storing an unregistered vehicle. For all permit renewals please complete this form and submit it at least 28 days before the expiry date of the existing permit.

All adjoining neighbours will be consulted by Council prior to a permit being issued.

## 3.14 STORAGE OF VEHICLES

- (1) A person must not without a permit, use any land to keep or allow to be kept, any more than one unregistered vehicle if any part of the vehicle is reasonably visible.
- (2) Subclause 1 does not apply to land where the storage of unregistered vehicles is a permitted under the planning scheme.

In deciding whether to grant a permit for the storage of vehicles, consideration will be given to:

(a) the zoning of the land;

Infringement Notice: 5 penalty units

- (b) the type and number of vehicles to be kept; and
- (c) the amenity of the neighbouring area.

If a permit is granted for the storage of vehicles, standard conditions may include the requirement for screening, restrictions on dismantling any vehicles on site, and strict grass and weed control around the storage area.

Court penalty: 15 penalty units
